Overview

Across Europe, countries and higher education institutions are actively involved in widening participation and student support, particularly supporting students with disabilities. Different countries and different institutions adopt approaches to student support which are in-line with national legislation and institution requirements.

In the document, different identified support measures concerning the areas of widening participation and student support adopted within European countries and the SALEIE partner institutions are identified and these are provided as separate case studies. The focus is on, but not exclusively, supporting students with disabilities. All case studies are provided in **English** and selected case studies are translated into identified European languages, as identified in the following table.




















