A number of **specific governmental bodies** and activities (**policies and initiatives**) relating to disability support in higher education are identified below:

Specific governmental bodies

- The Ministry of National Education (Ministerul Educatiei Nationale) – MEN. MEN is the statutory planning and policy development body for higher education and research in Romania.
- The Romanian National Disability Council (Federatia Consiliul National al Dizabilit?tii din Romania, FCNDR). FCNDR is a full member of the European Disability Forum. FCNDR Coordinates all activities related to social protection and promotion of the rights of persons with disabilities in Romania. It is the central body that elaborates policies, strategies and standards in the field of disability.
- The National Agency for Payments and Social Inspection – (Agentia National? pentru Pl?ti si Inspectie Social?) – ANPIS. ANPIS is the main body responsible for cash benefits, including cash benefits for persons with disabilities

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- The National Association of Blind People (Asociatia Nationala a Nevazatorilor din Romania) – ANNR.
